



Preparing Your Home for a Photo Shoot

- Contain pets in the garage or out of sight.
- Remove all vehicles from driveways and do not park directly in front of the house.
- Move garbage cans so they cannot be seen from the street.
- Remove all garden tools including hoses and sprinklers.
- Mow and rake yard.
- Sweep driveways, sidewalks and patios.
- Clear off counter tops in kitchen and bathroom areas.
- Remove photos, notes and papers from the refrigerator.
- Turn on all interior lights.
- Turn ceiling fans and televisions off.
- De-clutter rooms which may be excessively furnished. They do not photograph well.

- Make all beds and tidy bedrooms. Make sure all clothes are hung up, or put out of sight.
- Remove piles of newspapers and magazines.
- Tuck all indoor trash cans out of view in a closet or cupboard.
- Remove throw rugs, uninterrupted floor space looks larger in photographs
- Open Window covering to allow as much light as possible
